

What is the BOZEMAN CONVENIENCE SITE?

The BCS opened in 2008 for the convenience of the non-commercial District residents to dispose of regular household materials in small quantities only.

The BCS is equipped to accept:

- **Household Trash:** We have one stationary compactor and several roll-off bins
- **Scrap Metal:** We have one roll-off bin for metal items.
- **Compost/Wood:** a compost/clean wood area
- **Recycling:** We accept cardboard, mixed paper, aluminum & steel cans, and plastic bottles marked #1 or #2.

BCS does **NOT** accept:

- **Commercial loads of household trash, light construction materials, or heavy Construction materials**
- **Loads requiring a trailer, U-Haul, or dump truck**
- **Refrigerators / Air Conditioners**

Large and/or commercial loads must be taken to Logan Landfill off of I-90 Exit 283

BULKY ITEMS: \$5 fee per item + load fee

Includes mattresses, box springs, large furniture items, etc.

UNSECURED LOADS: Loads must be covered.

Unsecured loads may be assigned fees up to \$75

LATE FEES: Customers must be on the outbound scale

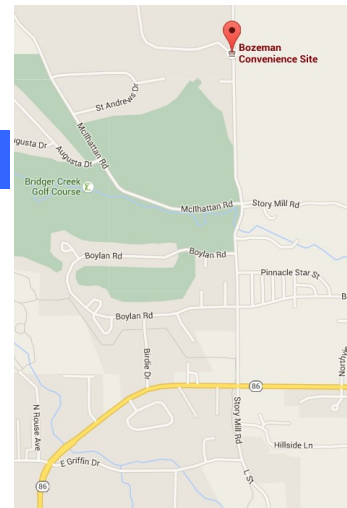

TRASH & Fees

NOTE: A \$10 minimum fee applies to all loads

REGULAR HOUSEHOLD TRASH \$27/ton

Kitchen waste, clothing, basic household trash.

No furniture or construction material may be placed in the compactor.

LIGHT CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL \$48/ton

2x4s, drywall, plywood, sawdust, insulation, carpet, furniture, etc.

CLEAN WOOD \$27/ton

Branches, limbs, untreated lumber, prunings, or other woody vegetation.

No Stumps, or trunks over 24" circumference with no rock or dirt balls.

COMPOST \$15/ton

Clean sawdust, leaves, grass clippings, hay, straw, limbs less than 1/4" in diameter, manure.

SMALL WHITE GOODS \$2 each

Water heaters, dishwashers, bicycles, ranges, washers, dryers, lawnmowers (fluids drained), etc.

Accepted forms of Payment

BCS accepts the following forms of payment:

- Cash
- Local Checks (**No out of state checks**)
- Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express
